Topic: Everyone Knows That... Right?? – A look at “common knowledge” and the fact that it is not common

Ever assume that everyone knows that? Often as technical experts we assume that everyone knows the same information that we do, especially when working in the same industry. However, everyone’s experience and resulting learning is different, and we must be aware of this and plan accordingly. This presentation will explore this topic through several examples, and offer insight that we as professionals should be aware of. “To some it is common knowledge, to others it is voodoo” – Manager – Electrical Systems, SaskPower.

Wayne Timm is a senior engineer with SaskPower with 35 years’ experience working in coal plant operations, hydro operations, engineering, cogeneration project engineering, power plant construction and commissioning, and most recently, commissioning SaskPower’s Carbon Capture facility.

Wayne obtained his degree at the University of Saskatchewan in Electrical Engineering, class of 1982. He is a member of the SaskPower Electric Safety Committee, an IEEE Senior Member, and a member of the IEEE PES, IAS, and SA. While working in hydro operations, he was involved in development and updating of IEEE hydro standards, and is currently a member of the working group that is updating IEEE 666 – IEEE Design Guide for Electric Power Service Systems for Generating Stations.

In 2016, Wayne was awarded the IEEE PES North Saskatchewan Chapter Outstanding Engineer Award, and in 2017 he was involved in balloting 12 IEEE standards.
